


The NGO « Électriciens sans frontières - Suisse » is created



Last November, a Constitutive Assembly sealed the creation of the NGO "Électriciens sans frontières – Suisse" (translation: "Electricians without boarders") in the French-speaking part of Switzerland at the premises provided by the ACVIE (Association Cantonale Vaudoise des Installateurs Électriciens).



The GOALS and FIELDS of ACTION of

this international solidarity association based on volunteering are:

> Development: study, promote, support and carry out development aid, solidarity and

cooperation projects for disadvantaged populations, by acting on access to electricity to meet needs such as education, health, access to water, security, economic development, environment and transfer of skills,

- ➤ **Emergency:** organize post-emergency and rehabilitation actions for the benefit of existing populations and organizations in regions in situations of humanitarian crisis,
- ➤ Expertise and support: putting their expertise in matters of access to electricity and water to the service of international solidarity actors.
